RESOLUTION SUPPORTING 2021-2022 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

WHEREAS, the City of River Falls staff has identified legislative proposals that directly improve operational and financial sustainability of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of River Falls requests the attention of its elected representatives to these issues;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of River Falls hereby supports the following legislative policy priorities:

- Improvements to The Emergency Detention Process;
- Support for Multi-Modal Transportation Long-Term Funding Solutions;
- COVID-19 Relief Assistance

BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of River Falls hereby supports the following legislative technical correction priorities:

- Allow Sharing Between Tax Increment Districts;
- Allow 10+ Year Financing;
- Modify Biennial Budgeting Process

BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of River Falls hereby supports the following state agency language changes priorities:


- Modifications to the WDNR Regionalization Grant

BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of River Falls hereby advocate support for the following community infrastructure and capital project items as priorities:

- Kinni Corridor Implementation
 - Powell dam removal: \$1,000,000
 - Restoration due to the removal of Powell dam: \$1,000,000
 - Downtown stormwater plan: \$3,000,000
- DOT Project ID: 7994-00-52 (Powell Ave. Bridge)
- UWRF Science & Technology Innovation Center
- West Central Wisconsin Bio-Solids Facility Improvements
 - Phase 1: \$16,300,000
 - Phase 2: \$2,400,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of River Falls, the City Administrator or his designee are directed to communicate items included in the City's 2021-2022 Legislative priorities to members of the State Legislature, United States Legislature, in general, and/or to appropriate legislative committees, committee members and others as appropriate.
